SPECIALIST PROGRAMMES

Kick Start Cyber Security

This OCN Level 2 programme focuses on developing the skills and knowledge of learners to safely and securely use information technology. In just 10 weeks, students will gain an understanding of the risks to security and how these may be prevented, how to perform cyber security precautions on devices and how to manage their own personal and organisational information online. This course will also include CV/interview skills and a 5 week work placement.

Women Returners Programme

This OCN Level 2 Programme is for women of all ages who have been out of the labour market for six months or more and want to restart their career journey. By the end of this 15-week employability programme, participants will have achieved a qualification in Business Administration skills.

Electric Vehicle

This UK Level 4 (ROI Level 6) course is validated by Atlantic Technological University (ATU) and is in collaboration with North West Regional College (NWRC). This unique 15-week cross border course will help learners advance their studies in Electric Vehicle (EV) technology and will see a blended approach of online and practical learning..

Environmental Sustainability

This Pearson Level 3 course is designed to give learners a basic understanding and knowledge of the environmental sustainability sector, particularly focusing on energy management, sustainable construction, and the principles of sustainable development. This one year course will provide you with a solid foundation of knowledge and skills in the field of environmental sustainability.
